## HOW DO I TRANSFER MY CLUB PERMITTED VEHICLE TO OR FROM GVC

VicRoads have advised that, subject to certain conditions, a permit for a vehicle under the VicRoads Club Permit (Log Book) system, may be transferred from one club to another, as follows:

The permit holder shall notify their 'old' club, of their intention to transfer the permit to the 'new' club.

The 'old' club would then need to notify VicRoads, of the deletion of the vehicle from their list of permitted vehicles (i.e. The vehicle cannot be permitted with two clubs at the same time).

Once the above is attended to GVC would then give the vehicle owner, a letter addressed to VicRoads, & signed by one of GVC's Club Permit Scheme officers, detailing the change & certifying that the vehicle owner is a financial member of GVC. As this is an administrative change only & the vehicle is already on the C.P.S., there should not normally be a requirement for a Roadworthy Certificate, or a change of permit number/plate/plates.

The only other thing GVC would need to know is the vehicle details, permit number & that the vehicle has NOT been modified. The owner would also need to sign a 'VICROADS CLUB PERMIT SCHEME – AGREEMENT WITH GVC' FORM. If the applicant needs further information, the VicRoads head office in Melbourne would probably be the best option (Ask for the 'Club Permit Scheme' contact person), as not all VicRoads staff, in the branches seem to be fully conversant with the above.
